Welcome to Project Nanny!

All our Babysitters and Nannies have gone through a rigorous screening process to make sure they are suitable for our team. We conduct interviews, reference checks and Police screen checks so you can trust that your children are in safe hands.

Enquiring about a Nanny? Here are some things you should know:

All our Nannies are independent contractors – this means they are not employed by either Project Nanny Ltd or you.

Once you have met and confirmed your new nanny you will receive a contract agreement - this is the agreement between yourself and the nanny. The agreement will state what is expected from both parties throughout the duration your nanny is with you and gives the placement structure.

At the end of the working week your nanny will submit her total hours worked and any kilometres driven in her own vehicle with your children. This is how your invoice is generated.

Project Nanny will take responsibility for paying your nanny's tax and all you must do is pay your invoice by Monday every week. All our nannies have their full drivers' licence and transport so all you need to provide is car seats.

Our aim is to make the process of having that extra set of hands to help simple and straightforward.

All placement fees are fully refundable if you are not satisfied with your Nanny for reasonable cause within 14 calendar days. If the Nanny is required to drive her own vehicle with your children, there will be a reimbursement fee of 0.79 cents per Kilometre.

If a temporary or permanent Nanny has been placed with you, the placement fee will be included in your first invoice.

Please note the difference between a babysitter and nanny

We classify a babysitter as a casual or one-off booking and a Nanny is a permanent/ temporary ongoing position.
